Stop any form of violence and ensure children are safe

Regarding the recent incidents which occurred in Admiralty, Central, Causeway Bay and Mongkok, the Against Child Abuse (ACA) urges the government, the organizers and concerned parties to ensure the safety of children (under 18-year olds) and that they are not treated with any form of violence. The ACA appeals for the followings:

- 1) People expressing views continue to stay calm, be rational and uphold the principle of non-violence.
- 2) Parents listen to their children's voices, discuss with them about the safety, the responsibilities and the possible consequences if they wish to take part in the action.
- 3) The government listens to the voice of young people and different sectors.
- 4) The police to exercise restraint and observe the principle of non-violence at all times.
