Child Abuse

Over half of Hong Kong children who responded to a recent survey said they had been beaten by their parents. **Against Child Abuse** interviewed more than 1,500 children aged between six and 13. Three quarters of those who admitted being physically abused said their parents struck them barehanded, while over 55 percent said they were beaten with objects. More than half of the children said this physical punishment was meted out for unsatisfactory school results. Mike Weeks asks **the director of Against Child Abuse** for more. (6.50)
